The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Manuel Moises Zambrano** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Manuel Moises Zambrano ("Respondent") is and was at all material times licensed as a life and variable life/annuities producer, Arizona license number 1089261, which expires November 30, 2017.
2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: 6155 N. Scottsdale Rd., Scottsdale, AZ 85250 (business and mailing).
3. On or about September 23, 2014, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident life and variable life/annuities producer, Arizona license number 1089261.
4. On June 12, 2015, the Department notified Respondent by mail at his address of record that his fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before July 13, 2015. Respondent did not reply to the Department's request.

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
ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent may surrender his insurance producer license, Arizona license number **1089261**.

2. The hearing, Docket #15A-166-INS, scheduled for February 2, 2016, at 1:00 p.m. is vacated.



4 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

5 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
6 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
7 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to
8 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative
9 action on any license application.


