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CONSENT ORDER

HAMILTON, LUKE ALLEN VICTOR (National Producer No. 18343106)

Respondent

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The Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Luke Allen Victor Hamilton ("Hamilton" or "Respondent") violated provisions of Title

20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S"). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without

the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Finding of Fact are true,

and consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Hamilton is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona bail bond agent. His license, number 18343106, was last renewed on March 6, 2017 and it is scheduled to expire on January 31, 2021.
- 2. Hamilton's business and mailing address of record with the Department are: C/O Didn't Do It Bail Bonds, 1837 South Mesa Drive, A-200, Mesa, Arizona 85210. Hamilton's business e-mail address of record with the Department is DIDNTDOITBAILBONDS@GMAIL.COM.

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Consumer Complaint / Rule Violation

- 2. On or about September 14, 2020, a consumer submitted a written complaint to the Department disputing the fees charged by the Respondent during the consumer's bail bond transaction in 2019.
- 3. The Department's investigation of the 2019 bail bond transaction revealed that the Respondent, on three separate occasions, accepted monies and vehicle titles from the consumer as collateral and/or premium for the bail bond contract.
- 4. On or about October 8, 2020, Hamilton advised the Department that he did not issue receipts to the consumer for the monies and vehicle titles received in connection to the consumer's 2019 bail bond. Hamilton acknowledged his awareness that bail bond agents are required to issue receipt for each collateral and premium payment received.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).
- 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes accepting monies or any other consideration for any bail bond undertaking without providing a pre-numbered receipt as evidence of payment to the person paying the monies or giving the considerations, a violation of A.R.S. § 20-340.01(G).
- 4. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend for not more than twelve months or revoke Respondent's insurance producer license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A) and (B)
 - 5. Grounds exist, in addition to or instead of any suspension or revocation, for the

1 Director to impose a civil penalty of not more than \$250.00 for each unintentional failure or violation up to an aggregate civil penalty of \$2,500.00, or impose a civil penalty of not more 2 3 than \$2,500.00 for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of \$15,000.00, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(F). 4 5 **ORDER** 6 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT: 7 Luke Allen Victor Hamilton shall immediately pay a civil penalty of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) for deposit into the state general fund. 8 Effective this ____9th __day of _____ November , 2020. 9 Evan of Dami 10 11 Evan G. - 5. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to induce him to enter into this Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.
- 6. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.
- 7. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledge that he must report this administrative action to any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on any license application.
