

1 Mr. Purk admits the following Findings of Fact are
2 true and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of
3 Law and Order.

4 FINDINGS OF FACT

5 1. Donald W. Purk is currently licensed as a life
6 and disability insurance agent (License No. 93524). That
7 license expired July 31, 1995. Mr. Purk has filed a timely
8 renewal application for that license.

9 2. On or about April 20, 1973, Mr. Purk submitted an
10 application for a life and disability insurance agent license
11 to the Department.

12 3. Question 12 of the application asks: "Have you
13 ever been arrested, taken into custody, held for investigation
14 or questioning, or charged by any law enforcement authority?
15 Mr. Purk answered "No" to the question.

16 4. During the period of August 1970 and September
17 1971, Mr. Purk was arrested, taken into custody, held for
18 investigation or questioning, or charged by law enforcement
19 authorities in San Bernardino, California; Seymour, Indiana;
20 Lima, Ohio; and/or Claremont, California.

21 5. On or about March 12, 1976, Mr. Purk submitted an
22 application for renewal of his life and disability insurance
23 agent license to the Department.

24 6. Question 11 of the renewal application asks:
25 "Have you ever been arrested, taken into custody, held for
26 investigation or questioning, or charged by any law enforcement

1 authority? Mr. Purk answered "Yes" to the question and
2 explained that he had forgot to pay a traffic fine for speeding
3 in Kingman, Arizona for \$66.00.

4 7. Mr. Purk failed to disclosed that during the
5 period of August 1970 and September 1971, he had been arrested,
6 taken into custody, held for investigation or questioning, or
7 charged by law enforcement authorities in San Bernardino,
8 California; Seymour, Indiana; Lima, Ohio; and/or Claremont,
9 California.

10 8. On or about September 13, 1977 and September 7,
11 1979, Mr. Purk submitted applications for renewal of his life
12 and disability insurance agent license to the Department.

13 9. Question 4 of the 1977 and 1979 renewal
14 applications asks: "Have you ever been served with a criminal
15 summons, questioned, arrested, taken into custody, indicted,
16 charged with, tried for, pled guilty to, or convicted of, or
17 ever been the subject of an investigation concerning the
18 violation of any felony or misdemeanor? Mr. Purk answered
19 "Yes" to the question and stated "See statement in your office."

20 10. Mr. Purk failed to disclosed that during the
21 period of August 1970 and September 1971, he had been arrested,
22 taken into custody, held for investigation or questioning, or
23 charged by law enforcement authorities in San Bernardino,
24 California; Seymour, Indiana; Lima, Ohio; and/or Claremont,
25 California.

2 2. The undersigned admits the jurisdiction of the
3 Department and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact and
4 consents to the foregoing Conclusions of Law and Order.

5 3. The undersigned states that no promises were made
6 to him to induce him to enter into this Consent Order and
7 declares that he has entered into this Consent Order
8 voluntarily.

9 4. The undersigned acknowledges that acceptance of
10 this Consent Order is for the purpose of settling this
11 litigation as against Donald W. Purk and does not preclude the
12 Department, or any other agency or officer of this State, or
13 subdivision thereof, from instituting other civil or criminal
14 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.


15 5. The undersigned waives all rights to challenge
