

The request for rehearing filed by the Respondent Edwin S. Mast is denied.





**RECOMMENDED ORDER
DENYING REHEARING**

On July 10, 1997, Edwin Stewart Mast ("Respondent") filed a request for rehearing ("Request") on the basis of not having been adequately prepared at the hearing. Counsel for the Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") filed a Response to Request for Rehearing or Review wherein the Department requested that Respondent's Request be denied for failure to enumerate any of the grounds set forth in A.A.C. R20-6-114. Having reviewed the above-mentioned documents, it is determined that the Respondent has failed to set forth sufficient grounds to support a rehearing of this matter.

Based on the above, the Administrative Law Judge recommends that Respondent's Request be denied.
