

## **Continuing Education Topic List**

Credit may be granted for education offerings that are consistent with the purpose of continuing education and cover those real property related appraisal topics, including, but not limited to:

a. Ad valorem taxation;
b. Arbitration, dispute resolution;
c. Courses related to the practice of real estate appraisal or consulting;
d. Development cost estimating;
e. Ethics and standards of professional practice, USPAP;
f. Land use planning, zoning;
g. Management, leasing, timesharing;
h. Property development, partial interests;
i. Real estate law, easements, and legal interests;
j. Real estate litigation, damages, condemnation;
k. Real estate financing and investment;
l. Real estate appraisal related computer applications;
m. Real estate securities and syndication;
n. Developing opinions of real property value in appraisals that also include personal property and/or business value;

o. Seller concessions and impact on value; and/or

p. Energy efficient items and "green building" appraisals.
